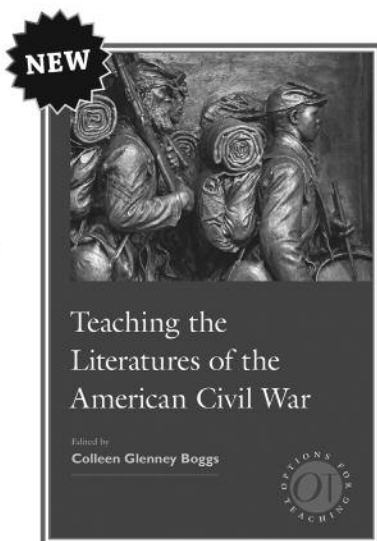
Teaching the Literatures of the American Civil War

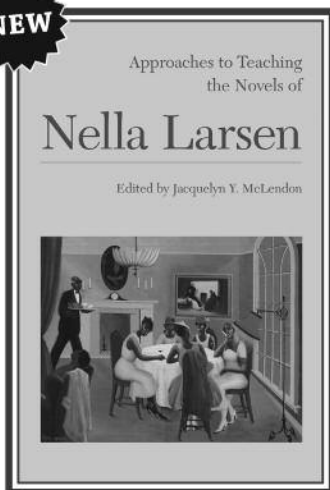
